SUBJECT: Minutes of the Commission's meeting on 21 April 2022

1. The meeting was called to order at 3:35PM in the lower town hall. Members present were: Mary Beauchamp, David Moriarty, Peter Emerick, Faye McCloskey, Jeffrey Brochu, Roy Henry, and Michael Potaski. James Beauchamp represented the Historical Society.
2. The minutes of the 24 March meeting were taken up. Peter Emerick moved that they be accepted and Roy Henry seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
3. The Commission discussed the lack of interest in the Farnum House pre-proposal conference.
4. Michael Potaski made a suggestion to submit the Farnum House for inclusion in Preservation Massachusetts' inventory of "Most Endangered Historic Resources. Peter Emerick moved that Potaski take the lead on the submission and David Moriarty seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
5. The Commission discussed the need for the town to begin planning its activities around the Semiquincentennial (250th) of the American Revolution in 2026 and the 300th anniversary in 2027 of the Town's incorporation. The consensus of the members was to approach the Board of Selectmen after the May town meeting and May elections.
6. There being no further business Michael Potaski moved that the meeting be adjourned and Faye McCloskey seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
