

**THE UXBRIDGE TOWN COMMON PRESERVATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 19, 2011 MEETING**

A Meeting of The Uxbridge Town Common Preservation Committee was held on October 19, 2011. The meeting was called to order on the Town Common by Chairman David Moriarty at 5:30 PM. Due to the Inclement weather the meeting adjourned to Jumbo Donuts.

Members present Chairman Moriarty, Vice Chairman Harry Romasco, Robert Harris, William Martin, William Robertson, Dennis Seely and Secretary Phyllis Smyth.

After the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Chairman Moriarty called on the Secretary to read the minutes of the May 21, 2011 meeting. Dennis Seely moved to accept and Robert Harris seconded and the minutes were approved as read.

The Secretary reported that the Board of Selectmen appointed William Robertson to serve on The Uxbridge Town Common Preservation Committee. The Committee members welcomed the new member to the Committee.

Vice Chairman Harry Romasco reported on the Solar Energy Grant Project. The Committee reviewed the project. Mr. Romasco provided pictures, size and dimensions. After discussion the Committee members agreed that the site and size of the equipment were not suitable for the Town Common. Mr. Romasco reported that the grant could be transferred to the Police Station for use at the Douglas Street Site. Dennis Seely moved that the Solar Energy Grant Project be transferred to the Police Department, William Robertson seconded and the motion was approved.


